EXCHANGE PROGRAM NOMINATION AND APPLICATION INFORMATION

University Nomination: Nominate via email to Anne Höch (incomings@zuv. uni-hannover.de). Nomination deadlines are 30 Apr for winter semester, Oct 31 for summer semester.

Student Application: Nominated students will receive an email from Anne Höch to apply via the application portal "MoveOn". You need:

- Learning Agreement (signed by your home university's study abroad coordinator)
- Transcript of records from home institution
- Copy of passport (if available)
- German B1 proof required only for courses taken in German.

Students email the generated pdf of the application, signed on the last page by the home university's study abroad coordinator to incomings@zuv.uni-hannover.de

Application deadlines: 31 May for winter semester, 30 Nov for summer semester.

Housing, meals and insurance: Students apply for housing through the international office on a first-come, first-served basis. Housing is limited. All rooms are single rooms with a shared kitchen (about 350 (month). Affordable meals are available at the cafeterias (3 – 6€ for lunch). Students must have health insurance that meets German federal requirements, e.g. German public insurance (about 128) month). The International Office of LUH will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Pre-Semester Intensive German Course: This optional 4-week is offered during the month before the semester starts. Course cost is approx. 350€.

WINTER SEMESTER

1 Oct 2024 – 31 Mar 2025 (Lecture period: 14 Oct – 1 Feb)

SUMMER SEMESTER

1 Apr – 30 Sep 2025 (Lecture period: 7 Apr – 19 Jul)

Orientation takes place 1-2 weeks before classes begin.

Most exams take place in the 2 weeks following the end of the lecture period.
