With project budgets ranging from €1.5 to €2.5 million and a funding duration of up to five years, the ERC Individual Grants represent prestigious recognition with attractive funding for excellent researchers in Europe:

- [Starting Grants](#): researchers with 2–7 years experience after PhD completion, ≤ €1.5 million
- [Consolidator Grants](#): researchers with 7-12 years experience after PhD completion, ≤ €2 million
- [Advanced Grants](#): established and outstanding researchers, ≤ €2.5 million
