EULiST Summer School 2025 at Leibniz University Hannover

We are pleased to announce the organisation of the **EULiST Summer School** for the year 2025. We cordially invite all members of Leibniz University Hannover to submit their applications for the organisation of this summer school.

Aims of the EULiST Summer School

The EULIST (European Universities Linking Society and Technology) alliance is an association of leading European universities aiming to link social and technological developments. The EULIST Summer School 2025 will support this goal through a programme aligned with the strategic priorities of the Alliance and with a special focus on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Programme content and design

The programme of the Summer School should be thematically oriented towards an area of particular relevance to the EULiST Alliance and to be closely linked to the SDGs. We have identified thematic synergies and priorities focusing on the following six <u>United Nations Sustainable Development Goals</u>:

- SDG 4 Quality Education
- SDG 6 Clean Water and Sanitation
- SDG 7 Affordable and Clean Energy
- SDG 9 Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure
- SDG 11 Sustainable Cities and Communities
- SDG 13 Climate Action

The programme is expected to include the following elements:

- Interdisciplinary presentations and workshops: Experts from Leibniz University Hannover, in cooperation with at least two other <u>EULIST partner universities</u>, will design the programme to ensure a diversity of scientific perspectives from the network.
- **Collaborative projects:** Participants work on practical, SDG-related challenges in international teams to promote intercultural and interdisciplinary collaboration.
- **Networking events:** Events that strengthen exchange and long-term networking between the participating institutions and participants.

Eligibility to apply and requirements

All members of Leibniz University Hannover are eligible to apply. Applicants should be able to develop a programme that both meets the scientific requirements of the EULiST alliance and addresses the objectives of EULiST. A prerequisite for funding is the conceptual involvement of at least two partner universities from the EULiST network.

Funding

Financial support of up to EUR 30,000 can be requested for the realisation of the EULiST Summer School 2025. These funds are intended to cover the costs incurred for travel and accommodation for participants, as well as other organisational expenses.

The following items are eligible for funding:

- Guest Speaker Fees (EUR 92/hour up to a maximum of EUR 2,383 in total)
- Personnel costs for coordination (top-up TVL 13 for max. 6 months, max. EUR 5,992)
- Teaching materials (EUR 150)
- Costs for catering (max. EUR 1,710)
- Travel expenses for students or doctoral candidates (max. EUR 4,590)
- Accommodation costs for students and doctoral candidates (max. EUR 17,100)
- Lump sum for programme activities (max. EUR 220)

Co-financing with other own or external funds is generally possible.

Submission of applications

Interested members of Leibniz University Hannover are requested to submit their application by **15 December 2024** via email to eulist@zuv.uni-hannover.de. The application must include the following documents:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. **Draft programme:** A detailed description of the planned programme.
- 3. Budget plan: A complete financial plan showing all anticipated costs and sources of funding.

Timetable

- Application deadline: 15 December 2024
- Notification of selection decision: By the middle of January 2025
- Implementation of the Summer School: In 2025
